Elections. Watch for your ballot, it will be coming in the mail. Sanpete County's Clerk office will be a vote center for all voters in Sanpete County. The ballots will be mailed out on October 5th. If you have not received your ballot by October 8th, please call the clerk's office at 835-2131. They will check to see if a ballot was sent, and if not, what needs to be done to get one sent to you. Please verify that you are registered to vote and that your address is correct. Election mail is not forward-able, if the address is incorrect, your ballot will be returned to the Clerk's office. One way to check is to go to vote.utah.gov, then click on "my voter profile". Enter your name, birth date, house number, and select the county you reside in. Click submit. If you are registered to vote, your information will be shown. Check to see that your addresses are correct. If either address is not correct, you can click on "register to vote", and follow the instructions to register to vote online. The website will also help you enter the correct information in your driver license file if needed.
