FAIRVIEW CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2022-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2008-01, FAIRVIEW CITY ZONING ORDINANCE "A LAND USE ORDINANCE OF FAIRVIEW CITY" DATED NOVEMBER 3, 2008, PART B, CHAPTER 17, "ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE", CHANGING ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE TO ANIMAL STANDARDS AND MOVING THE CONTROL BACK TO THE CODE OF REVISED ORDINANCES OF FAIRVIEW

WHEREAS the title "Animal Control Ordinance" on Chapter 17, is misleading,

WHEREAS Chapter 17, is not meant to represent an animal control ordinance but a standard for zoning of animals,

WHEREAS Chapter 17, in the Land Use Ordinance, needs to be changed to reflect those matters which deal with land use,

WHEREAS Animal Control is addressed in the Code of Revised Ordinances of Fairview City, Chapter 13-200, and

WHEREAS with amending Chapter 17 in the Land Use Ordinance it eliminates uncertainty regarding enforcement and moves it to Chapter 13-200 of the Code of Revised Ordinances of Fairview City to stipulate the course of action needed to enforce the violation as a Class C misdemeanor and/or so forth.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Fairview City, County of Sanpete, State of Utah, that Land Use Ordinance No. 2008-01, Chapter 17 be amended with the following changes:

Chapter 17, Change heading from Animal Control Ordinance to Animal Standards;

Section 1702, Domestic Fowl, Domestic Farm Animals, and Pets, **remove** bulletin point thirteen which reads "Any violation of this ordinance...." and **add** as its own section;

Section 1703, Limitations on the Keeping and Maintenance of Animals and Fowls, the last seven (7) bulletin points be **removed** for the reason that they are addressed in Chapter 13-200 Animal Control of the Code of Revised Ordinance of Fairview City; and

Add a new Section 1707, Violation; To read... Any violation of Chapter 17 will be fined \$50 for the first (1st) violation; \$100 for second (2nd) violation, and \$250 for third (3rd) violation. Additional violations may result in a Class C misdemeanor charge against the homeowner or renter.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting in three public places within the City.
